

Care of Instructional Materials

Library books, textbooks, computer devices, and other instructional materials are loaned to students for their use by the Clinton Public Schools, and shall be returned when requested by school district personnel. School district personnel shall ensure that students take proper care of books and other materials, and shall instruct students on their proper use. Students must pay the current value of any book or educational material that is lost or damaged beyond ordinary wear. Parents shall be notified if students have not made restitution on lost or damaged materials within a reasonable amount of time. The Clinton Board of Education may impose sanctions against students who lose or damage textbooks, computer devices, or instructional materials of any kind.

The Superintendent of Schools, working in conjunction with school district personnel, is authorized to set a schedule of appropriate fees, fines and charges for damaged or lost instructional materials or the use of specific school privileges, equipment or services.
